Got printing equipment in Southern California?

Unless your facility qualifies under a special rule that primarily exempts those with very low usage of inks and solvents, you must comply with the South Coast Air Quality Management District's (SCAQMD's) permitting requirements. Permits are required for both printing equipment and corresponding air pollution control equipment. Affected facilities are those that operate in the region that is under the SCAQMD's jurisdiction: Los Angeles, Orange and Riverside Counties, as well as parts of San Bernardino County.
